Background: Aiolos transcription factor is a member of the Ikaros family of zinc-finger proteins. Aiolos is a hemopoietic-specific transcription factor that regulates B lymphocyte proliferation and differentiation. It can also participate in chromatin remodeling.

Immunogen: This Aiolos antibody was raised against a recombinant GST-Tagged protein corresponding to the C-terminal half of mouse Aiolos.

Buffer: Rabbit antisera with 30% glycerol containing 0.035% sodium azide. Sodium azide is highly toxic.


Applications Validated by Active Motif:

WB: 1:500 dilution

The protein migrates around 70 kDa, and multiple isoforms may be detected due to alternative splicing as seen in the example Western blot image.

Storage and Guarantee: Some products may be shipped at room temperature. This will not affect their stability or performance. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles by aliquoting items into single-use fractions for storage at -20°C for up to 2 years. Keep all reagents on ice when not in storage. This product is guaranteed for 12 months from date of receipt.
